1. MPE presented Council with a preliminary concept design for The Broadway and Frederick Avenue.
2. Canadian Fiber Optics presented to Council Broadband Market Model and Cost to supply Fiber to 175 premises and to the industrial park. Current supernet at 25mg would provide better speeds than what the Village currently has with the wireless network of between 5-10mg. Fiber has limitless capacity.
Backhaul connection to Standard needs to be upgraded to be future proof at 1g.
3. 06-17-20-02 Moved by M.Gauthier that the campground and sewer dump and fill station be re-opened to the public with the proper signs that the are is not sanitized and to take precautions. CARRIED
